## NEW PARK BY-LAW WINTER PARKING REMINDER

This by-law is part of our ongoing efforts to improve road safety, accessibility, and winter maintenance.

As a reminder winter parking regulations are in effect annually from November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 15<sup>th</sup> which typically includes no parking on municipal roads between 1 AM to 6 AM. This includes bus and snow plow turnarounds and boat launch areas.

#### **IMPORTANT - BEFORE YOU BUILD**

Building on municipal land creates title issues for a landowner and liability issues for the municipality. We do not allow building on these lands, cutting down vegetation, or the construction of decks for examples. We urge everyone to consult with the Township's building or by-law department before taking any action on their waterfront property.
